

RESOLUTION ENDORSING PAVED PATHWAYS
FOR HATTERAS ISLAND VILLAGES

WHEREAS, Hatteras Island is an unincorporated area in the County of Dare, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Hatteras Island citizens have determined a need for paved, off-road pathways through Hatteras Island villages because of unsafe walking and cycling conditions along N.C. 12 and increased vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, in 2003, the Board of Commissioners of Dare County appointed an Outer Banks Scenic Byway Committee. Through community-based planning, this committee has developed conceptual plans for paved pathways along N.C. 12 through the villages of Rodanthe, Waves, Salvo, Avon, Buxton, Frisco and Hatteras, North Carolina;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the County of Dare

(1) Endorses the conceptual plans for paved pathways through Hatteras Island villages as presented by its Outer Banks Scenic Byway Committee on August 7, 2006; and

(2) Forwards these conceptual plans to the Albemarle Rural Planning Organization and North Carolina Department of Transportation Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation Division with a recommendation for favorable action; and

(3) Authorizes the Dare County Manager or a designee to work with the North Carolina Department of Transportation's Divisions of Highways and Bicycle and Pedestrian Transportation to facilitate implementation of these plans.
