WHEREAS, the project site for such proposed public access is located at the old Manns Harbor Marina, which has historically been a working waterfront and

WHEREAS, Dare County, acting as sponsor for the project at the request of the Division of Marine Fisheries, has submitted a pre-application for a CAMA access grant and

WHEREAS, the pre-application has been approved and a final application has been requested and

WHEREAS, a duly advertised public hearing was held this day to receive public comments,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dare County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the submission of a final application for funding from the Public Beach and Coastal Waterfront Access Program Grant.

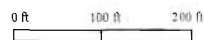
Acquisition Budget CAMA Grant
