OFFICIAL/SCOREKEEPER'S CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Dare County Parks and Recreation youth sport official/scorekeeper, I will:

2. Conduct myself in such a way that spectator attention is aimed at those playing the game and directed away from me.
3. Dress and maintain my appearance in a manner befitting the dignity and importance of the game.
4. Conduct myself so as to be a worthy example to those playing the game and to the fans.
5. Be fair and unbiased in my decisions.
6. Give complete cooperation and loyalty to all Parks and Recreation supervisors.
7. Cooperate and be professional in my associations with fellow officials/scorekeepers and will do nothing to cause them public embarrassment.
8. Be firm, but never overbearing; courteous; positive, but never rude, dignified, but never cocky; friendly; calm; and always alert.
9. Be prepared, both physically and mentally, to properly administer the game.
10. Not use tobacco products, drink any alcoholic beverages, or any type of drug on Dare County Property.
11. Always do the best job I possibly can.
